WHAT IS THE **DREDGING?**

Hidraulic arm to dig sediment

River "Misstep"

It is a technique that consists of cutting and removing the sediments that are found in the bottom of the rivers and opening the channel for large draft vessels.

LOCATION

Departments: Loreto and Ucayali.

Rivers: Amazonas. Ucayali, Marañón and Huallas

The opening dredging in the rivers is 8 feet (2.44 meters) and the entrance dredging to the port of Iquitos is 11 feet (3.35 meters).

There is no information or complete research on the variability of the Amazonian rivers from the physical and biological point of view, nor are there studies of the flow of sediments and dunes. which are indispensable for predicting the impacts of the Amazon Waterway.

Poor social base line

It is deficient for the cultural aspect of the affected population.

Latent danger of corruption

The company Construcción y Administración S.A. (CASA), part of the Cohidro consortium, is part of the "Club de la construcción" ("Construction Club"), involved in corruption scandals.

Great cost of the mega project

The initial budget is US\$ 95 million, but it is very likely that addenda and unforeseen additional expenses will end up costing the country much more, and therefore all of us, as it happened with the highway, Interoceanica Sur.

Dredging will reduce fish reproduction, which will seriously affect the fishing activity and the food source for the indigenous and local population.
